SCHEDULE:

Junior, Novice & Master registration	8:30 – 9:30 a.m.
Senior registration	9:30 – 10:30 a.m.
Master competition begins	10:00 a.m.
Junior competition begins	11:00 a.m.
Senior competition begins	Immediately following juniors

ELIGIBILITY: All contestants must provide a valid USJF, USJI, or USJA card. Foreign contestants must have the proper ID from their home country. Membership registration will also be available at the site.

SCORING: Modified Double Elimination (4 or more in a division);
Round Robin (3 or fewer in a division)

MATCH TIMES: Senior Men & Women Black & Brown Divisions, 5 min.;
Novice Divisions, 2 mins. (see special rules);
All other Divisions, 3 min.

RULES: The current rules of the International Judo Federation (IJF) as modified.

1. GOLDEN SCORE will apply to ALL DIVISIONS.
2. NO Kansetsu waza allowed in Junior Division
3. Shime waza allowed for 13 yrs. of age and up
4. Kansetsu waza allowed in all senior divisions regardless of age. (min. age for Sr. div. is 13)
5. 2002 Medical Rules
6. If you wear a blue gi, you must also have a white gi.
7. Must be in judo gi to receive your medal
8. **Special rules for the 4-12 Junior Novice Divisions:** These are two-minute matches that run to the full time limit. Scores are added up at the conclusion to determine the winner. There will be a three ippon limit. (These rules are designed to give novices as much mat time and experience as possible.)
9. Novice competitors can also compete in more advanced divisions.

AWARDS: Medals for first, second, and third place winners.

DETOUR ALERT:

GPS AND ONLINE MAP USERS, PLEASE NOTE THAT THE RT. 19/MARSHALL AVE./CALIFORNIA AVE. EXIT RAMP FROM NORTHBOUND RT. 65 IS CLOSED. IF YOU'RE COMING FROM THE EAST, SOUTH OR WEST, YOU'LL NEED TO FOLLOW THE POSTED DETOUR ABOUT ½ MILE BEFORE THAT EXIT, AT THE WEST END BRIDGE INTERSECTION.

We recommend this posted detour:

- About a half mile before the Rt. 19/Marshall/California exit, take the ramp to Western Ave. at the West End Bridge intersection.
- Follow Western Avenue to Allegheny Avenue
- Turn left onto Allegheny Ave. and continue to Pennsylvania Ave.
- Make right onto Pennsylvania Ave.
- Turn left onto Brighton Rd.
- Oliver High School is .8 mile away on your left at 2323 Brighton Rd.
