In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, the **2018 O. J. Helvey Kentucky State Judo Championship**, and related events and activities of United States Judo Association, United States Judo, Inc., United States Judo Federation, Kentucky Judo Council, Inc., Toshi Dojo Judo Club, and Meade County High School; I hereby:

- 1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
- 2. Agree that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
- 3. Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent **traumatic brain injury**, disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due to not only my own actions, inactions, or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
- 4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability, or death.
- 5.
