- 2) The <u>2017 Ohio Open Judo Championships</u> will be held on March 18th in Lima, Ohio Mark Hunter and Mike Mooney will be the tournament co-directors tournament flyer is posted on the Ohio Judo Website.
- 3) We plan to hold a "Super Saturday" late spring this is an event where there is something for everyone (competitive clinic/workout; promotion requirements; kata; referee training; timers/scorers clinic and practice competition)
- 4) We are looking at holding a <u>Judo Summer Camp in Ohio</u> this year. The proposed site is Wittenberg University near Springfield. More info to follow and it will be posted on the OJI Website as it becomes available.
- 5) <u>Club visitations</u> if you would like to travel to another club or host another club contact Ray Smith or me.
- 6) <u>Financial support for top OJI members</u> who place at our State Championships and compete at selected major regional events and/or various national championships.
- 7) Reactivation of the <u>state travel team program</u> points will be awarded at the Ohio Open in March.
- 8) Scholarship recognition program ATTENTION High School students recognizes academic achievement of OJI members at the "Honors" level for 3.0 GPA for the year and "High Honors" level for 3.5 GPA for the year. Seniors with an overall (4 year) GPA of 3.5 or higher are ranked and top 5 GPA's are awarded a small scholarship to be used at the college of their choice. - 9) <u>Certification for Coaches, Referees, Timers/Scorers, etc.</u> will be offered dates and locations to be announced. Note: An on-line Referee Training Program is offered on the OJI web site and is free.
