




OJI Presidential Notes

1) Scholarship (Academic Achievement) recognition program – Two High School Seniors have met the requirements and have been selected as Ohio Judoka Academic Scholarship recipients for 2017. Each will receive a small monetary award when they start college this Fall. Josh Kastner is a member of the Kettering Rec Center Judo Club and holds the senior rank of Ikkyu. He lives in Beavercreek, Ohio and has a cumulative GPA of 4.0 (on a 4.0 max scale) for 9th Grade through the first half of 12th Grade and will be attending college this coming Fall. Rose Tyler graduates from Beavercreek High School this May and is also a member of the Kettering Rec Center Judo Club. Rose holds the senior rank of Nikyu and has a qualifying overall GPA of 3.94 (on a 4.0 max scale).
