- 2) Referee Training for 2018 There will be a series of Referee Clinics and Seminars during next year. The first will be held on Saturday, January 13<sup>th</sup> in conjunction with a development mini-shiai at the Kettering Recreation Center (Kettering, OH). Implementation of the 2018 IJF Rules/Modifications will be covered and used at the mini-shiai. This program is meant to benefit those interested in becoming a referee as well as all referees of all certification levels.
- 3) Ronin Joint Workout (11/18/17) The fourth joint workout for 2017 was held at the Ronin Training Center in Columbus, OH and again proved to be a successful setting for some good training. There

were a good number of participants and instructors with the group breaking into four sections for the morning clinic session and then a combined afternoon randori session was held.
