

Masked Sensei Online Judo Championships (MJOC)

Eligibility:

Any child (15 years of age and under) who practices judo

Contestants may enter more than one category but can only be in one age division within each category.

Online Registration:

www.KokushiMidwest.com Click on the MJOC button and register online.

There will also be one "All Around Winner" for those demonstrating all three techniques.

Video Criteria:

Child must say their name, age and club before demonstrating the technique. Video must show the full body. Child must be in uniform during the video demonstration.

Requirements:

Demonstrate AND record your solo uchikomi (10 repetitions, either side) in a chosen category. Upload to the MSOJC DropBox (link will be given AFTER registration has been completed).

Entry fee:

1 category: \$20
2 categories: extra \$10
3 categories: extra \$5

Categories: Osotogari or Seoi Nage or Harai goshi

Entry fee includes participation certificate and opportunity to Masked Sensei in a clinic.

Age divisions:

7 and under, 8-11 yrs old, 12-15yrs old*

Important dates:

October 1, 2020 – video submissions are due.

October 7, 2020 – winners announced.

October 10, 2020 @ 1pm – Masked Sensei Meet and Greet

*12-15yrs old are divided into Novice (orange belt and below) and Advanced (Green belt and up)

Prizes:

There are 12 possible categories with 13 winners. Winners will be determined based on effort, sharpness, and consistency over the 10 repetitions. EACH WINNER will be awarded a custom portrait of them as a "Yellow Cartoon Character" in their judo gi. I can't say the actual name associated with the character but it starts with "S" and ends in "impsons". (See sample) This portrait will require a couple digital pictures of your child and will take 1-2 weeks after the artist receives your child's pictures. This will be a digital file only.



All contestants will be awarded a participation certificate and an invitation to attend the Masked Sensei Zoom session on October 10 @ 1pm CDT. This is NOT a judo workout, but a "Talk with the Champion" session.

Our Masked Sensei wants to have as many people as possible at this session. Sensei is a 3x Olympic medalist and World Champion. Sensei wants to know meet with all the kids and talk about being a high level athlete, and how it feels to win AND lose, and about just being yourself. Sensei says the kids can ask anything – about the medals, about Sensei's career (famous battles!), favorite technique, about Sensei's favorite foods, about Sensei's favorite dog, about Sensei's favorite hair style or even Sensei's house. ANYTHING.
