<u>June 2019</u>

- 1) <u>DAMAC Judo Club hit by tornado</u> Let's get it operational again! Last Monday three tornadoes hit the Dayton area and caused damage in Trotwood, Dayton, Huber Heights and Beavercreek, as well as several other outlying areas. Fortunately no-one in the Dayton area was killed (there was one death in Celina from this line of storms) but numerous people were injured and a significant amount of property damage was recorded. The Judo community here was spared (to my knowledge) from any injury but they did encounter property damage, including the DAMAC dojo. Much of their equipment and their facility is no longer usable. A fund has been established to assist with their recovery and reopening in a new location. If you can help, please send donations (checks payable to DAMAC) to Dayton Martial Arts Center, 926 W.
